Coronavirus Capital Projects Fund Awards for Tribal Governments

Treasury has approved the following Tribal projects using funds provided by the Capital Projects Fund. Information about Tribal government awards will be updated as additional projects are reviewed and approved by Treasury and awards are made available to Tribal governments.

Delaware Nation, Oklahoma	Anadarko, OK	Digital Connectivity Technology	\$167,504	This project will entail the purchase of laptops and tablets for households to use on-site, or check out for home use, as well as the purchase of equipment required to establish secure public Wi-Fi networks.
Ewiiapaayp Band of Kumeyaay Indians, California	Alpine, CA	Broadband Infrastructure	\$167,504	This project will contribute to the deployment of broadband infrastructure facilities and services to the off-grid area of the Ewiiapaayp Indian Reservation.
Kashia Band of Pomo Indians of the Stewarts Point Rancheria, California	Santa Rosa, CA	Digital Connectivity Technology	\$167,504	Funds will be used to establish facilities at a community center and housing facility for laptops and tablets, which may be used on-site or checked out. Equipment will also be purchased which will enable access to secure public Wi-Fi networks.
Nansemond Indian Nation	Suffolk, VA	Digital Connectivity Technology	\$167,504	This project will entail the purchase of equipment to extend the public Wi-Fi access. Currently, on a 70-acre property there is only broadband access at the central buildings; this project will allow Tribal Members to connect from anywhere on the property.

Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma	Miami, OK	Digital Connectivity Technology, and Multi-purpose Community Facility	\$167,504	Funds will be used to purchase laptops and supporting software, and to rehabilitate a room where the devices are used and stored.
Rampart Village	Rampart, AK	Multi-purpose Community Facility	\$167,504	Funds will be used to construct a multi-purpose building that will be used for education, work training, and health activities.
Southern Ute Indian Tribe of the Southern Ute Reservation, Colorado	Ignacio, CO	Broadband Infrastructure	\$167,504	This project entails funding permitting and environmental planning fees required to support a larger fiber-to-home project.
Stockbridge Munsee Community, Wisconsin	Bowler, WI	Broadband Infrastructure	\$167,504	This project entails the continuation of installation of fiber optic cables.
Tonkawa Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma	Tonkawa, OK	Digital Connectivity Technology	\$167,504	This project will entail the purchase of routers and other equipment, to enable 100 homes to connect to the internet.
